# FORUM LOCATION

## VENUE INFORMATION



The main Forum venue is:

**Palais des Congrès Conference Center** [Boulevard de la Marina, Cotonou].

The Palais des Congrès is located on the seaside of Cotonou, near Palce de l'Amazone, 3 km from the Cotonou Cadjehoun International Airport, 3 km from Benin Royal Hotel.

The Wednesday splinter sessions will take place at the **Benin Royal hotel**.







## **ACCOMMODATION**

### **ACCOMMODATION FOR SPONSORED PARTICIPANTS**

Sponsored participants will be accommodated at either the **Benin Royal Hotel** (Maro Militaire Neighbourhood) or **Nobila Hotel** (near the Airport).

Upon your arrival, the welcome committee at the airport will inform you of your designated hotel and will arrange transportation to take you there.

EUMETSAT will cover the cost of the accommodation. This includes room, breakfast, wireless internet connection, tourist and municipal taxes, as well as local transport between the airport and the hotel and between hotel and conference venue.

Participants will have to pay for all other expenses (bar, minibar, laundry, telephone, fax, supplementary meals, etc.).

EUMETSAT will take care of the hotel reservations for sponsored participants.

#### **ACCOMMODATION FOR NON-SPONSORED PARTICIPANTS**

It is recommended to non-sponsored participants to book their accommodation in the Benin Royal or Nobila hotels or others located near the Palais des Congrès, Cotonou e.g. <u>Golden Tulip</u>, Ibis and Novotel Hotels.

However, no local transport will be arranged from these hotels to the conference venue. Participants will have to make their own arrangement for local transport.

#### LANGUAGES AT THE FORUM

The working languages of the Forum are English and French, and EUMETSAT has made arrangements for simultaneous interpretation services to be provided.

## **TECHNICAL VISIT**

As part of the 16th EUMETSAT User Forum in Africa, a technical visit will be organised by the host. The visit will take place in Ouidah, a historic town located approximately 1 hour from Cotonou.

- Date: Wednesday, 18 September 2024
- Time: Afternoon (Exact departure times will be communicated during the forum)
- Departure: Buses will depart from the Benin Royal hotel just after lunch.

Additional information about the technical visit will be provided on the event website and by email to all participants. During the Forum check-in, you will be required to confirm your participation in the technical visit.

## **LOCAL TRANSPORT**

#### AIRPORT TRANSFERS

**Sponsored Participants**: EUMETSAT will provide transport to and from the airport **Non-Sponsored Participants**: You will need to contact your hotel directly to arrange airport transfers.









#### LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

#### **Hotel to venue transfers:**

EUMETSAT will provide transportation from the Benin Royal and Nobila hotels to and from the meeting venue, as well as to social events.

Non-Sponsored Participants: If you are staying at a different hotel, you will need to arrange your own transportation to the venue and social events.

#### **Public transport/Taxi options**

For non-sponsored participants staying at different hotels, information on public transport and taxi services will be available at the forum or can be inquired directly at your hotel.

## TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

#### VISA INFORMATION

All nationals of the African Union (except SADR) are exempt from visa requirements for entries that do not exceed 90 days. Therefore, <u>nationals from these countries will NOT need</u> a visa to travel for the Forum in Benin.

If you are a holder of a different passport than those mentioned above, please consult the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Benin to determine if you need a visa and, if so, its category (ordinary or referral).

## **VISA ACQUISITION METHODS**

**E-Visa:** Submit your visa application and payment online at the following page: https://evisa.bj/ (payment of \$50 by credit card). Within 48 hours, you will receive a visa acceptance letter, which you must present at the departure airport for your flight and upon arrival in Cotonou to obtain your visa.

**Embassy or Consulate**: Submit your visa application directly to the embassy or consulate of Benin in your country before your departure.

If you encounter difficulties in obtaining your visa for Benin, please contact the Secretariat of the User Forum in Africa (ufa@eumetsat.int) as soon as possible, and they will assist you as much as possible in your efforts.

#### TRAVEL AND HEALTH INSURANCE

Each participant (sponsored or non-sponsored) is responsible to have its own travel and health insurance to cover for her/his stay in Benin.

EUMETSAT will not reimburse insurance or medical expenses occurred by any participants. Hence please make your own arrangements for travel insurance as necessary.









## FLIGHT TICKET (FOR SPONSORED PARTICIPANTS)

Sponsored participants will receive their electronic ticket as soon as they confirm your itinerary, after your confirmation, it will no longer be possible to change the itinerary.

- Each sponsored participant will receive the routing with the ETIX reservation number by email.
- Participants are requested to print the itinerary with the reservation number and visit the
  airline to ensure that everything is correct and that the boarding pass(es) will indeed be
  issued on the day of departure. In case you are travelling with several airlines, please visit
  them all if possible;
- If there are problems, there is still time to solve them, and EUMETSAT will work on them directly to find a solution.

# LOCAL INFORMATION

#### **CURRENCY**

The official currency of the Benin Republic is the West African CFA franc (XOF). The easiest foreign currency to exchange is Euros. Alternatively, you can also withdraw cash from ATMs, which are widely available in Cotonou.

#### **WEATHER**

Benin has a tropical or equatorial climate, and is hot and humid year-round, with temperatures and humidity particularly high along the coast.

In September you can expect in Cotonou: commonly rain, often thunderstorm and heat waves. Typically, the temperature fluctuates around 28°C and the wind is gentle breeze.

#### **INTERNATIONAL DIALING & POWER**

Benin Country Code: +229

It is relatively easy to purchase local SIM cards. You will need your passport as ID to purchase the sim card and your phone will have to be unlocked.

The main companies providing GSM networks are Bell Benin Communications (BBCOM), Etisalat Benin SA (TELECEL BENIN), Spacetel-Benin (MTN) and Glomobile Benin Limited (GloBenin).

Benin operates on 220 volt electricity.
