Adoption of the African Space Policy and Strategy by the Heads of State and Government

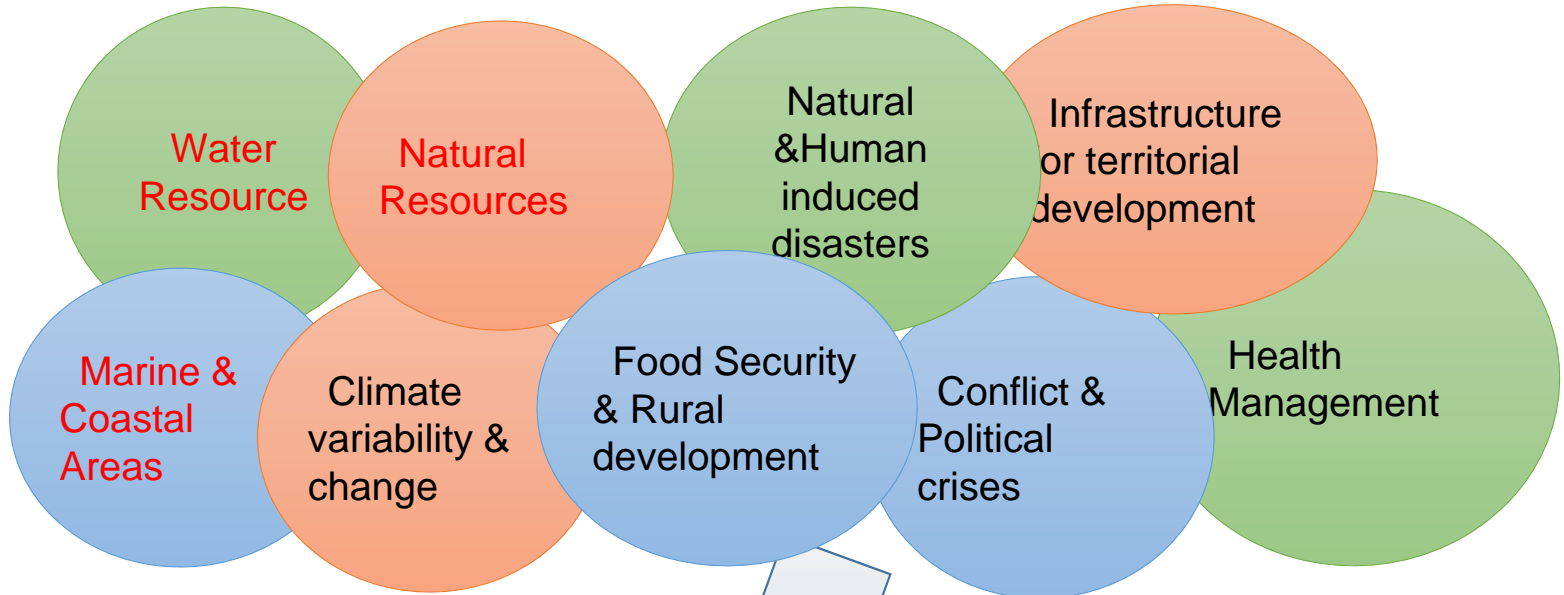
Space Policy and Strategy to formalize a sustainable African Space program with the following themes:

4. Space Science and Astronomy

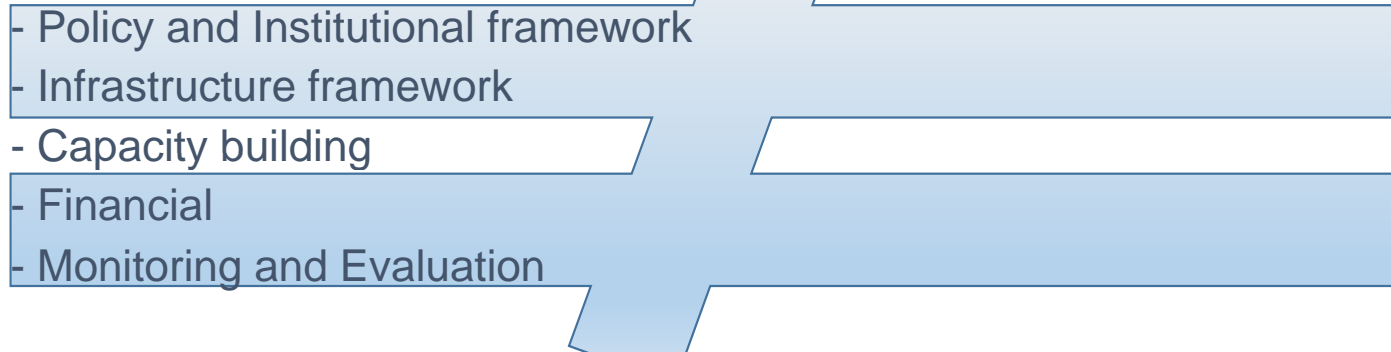

Plan of Action Thematic Areas

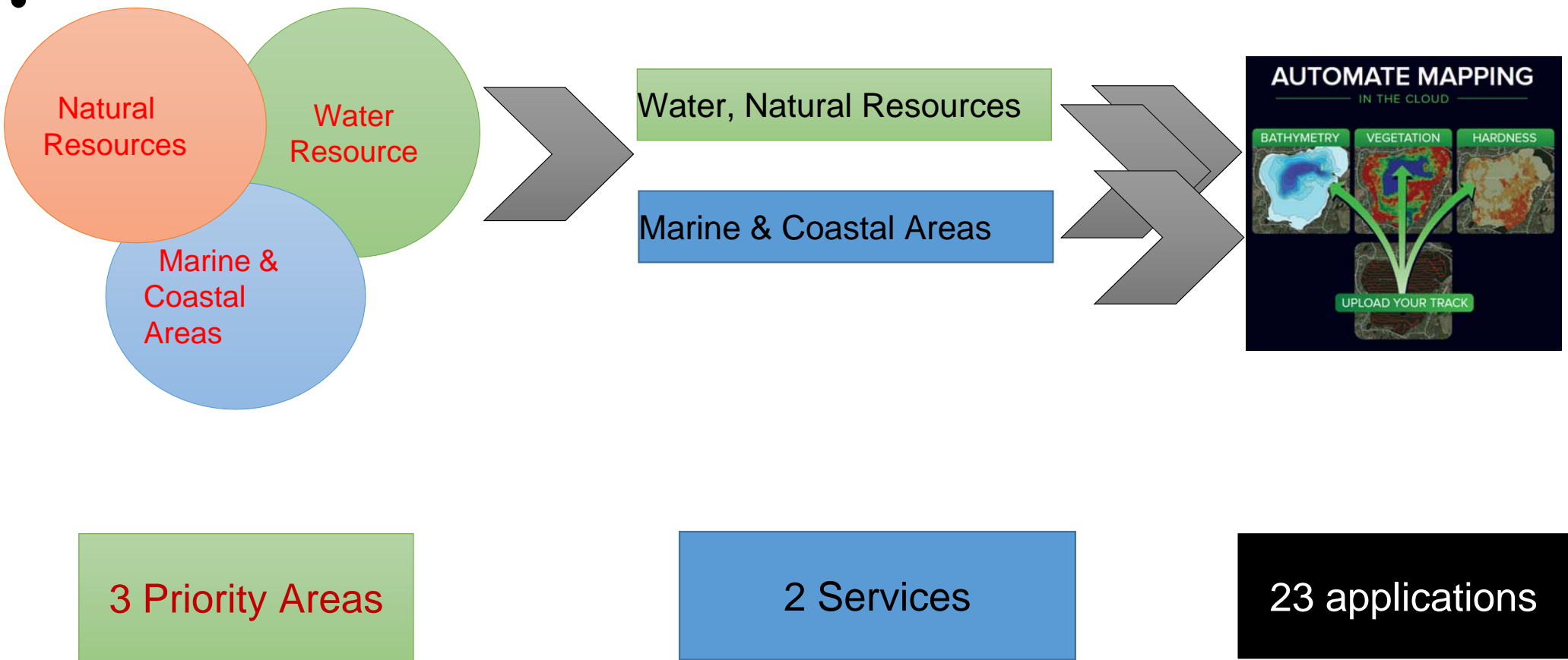

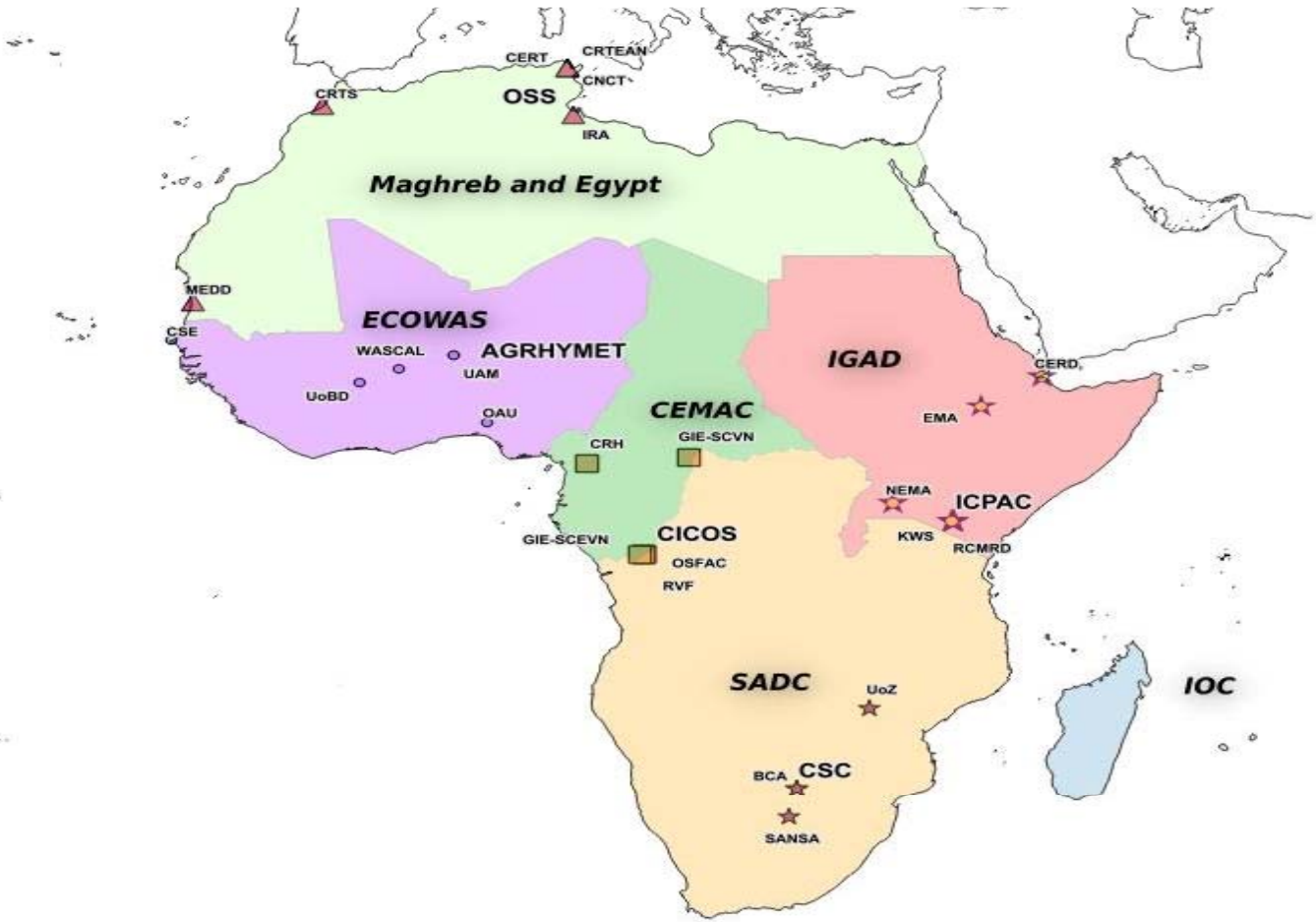

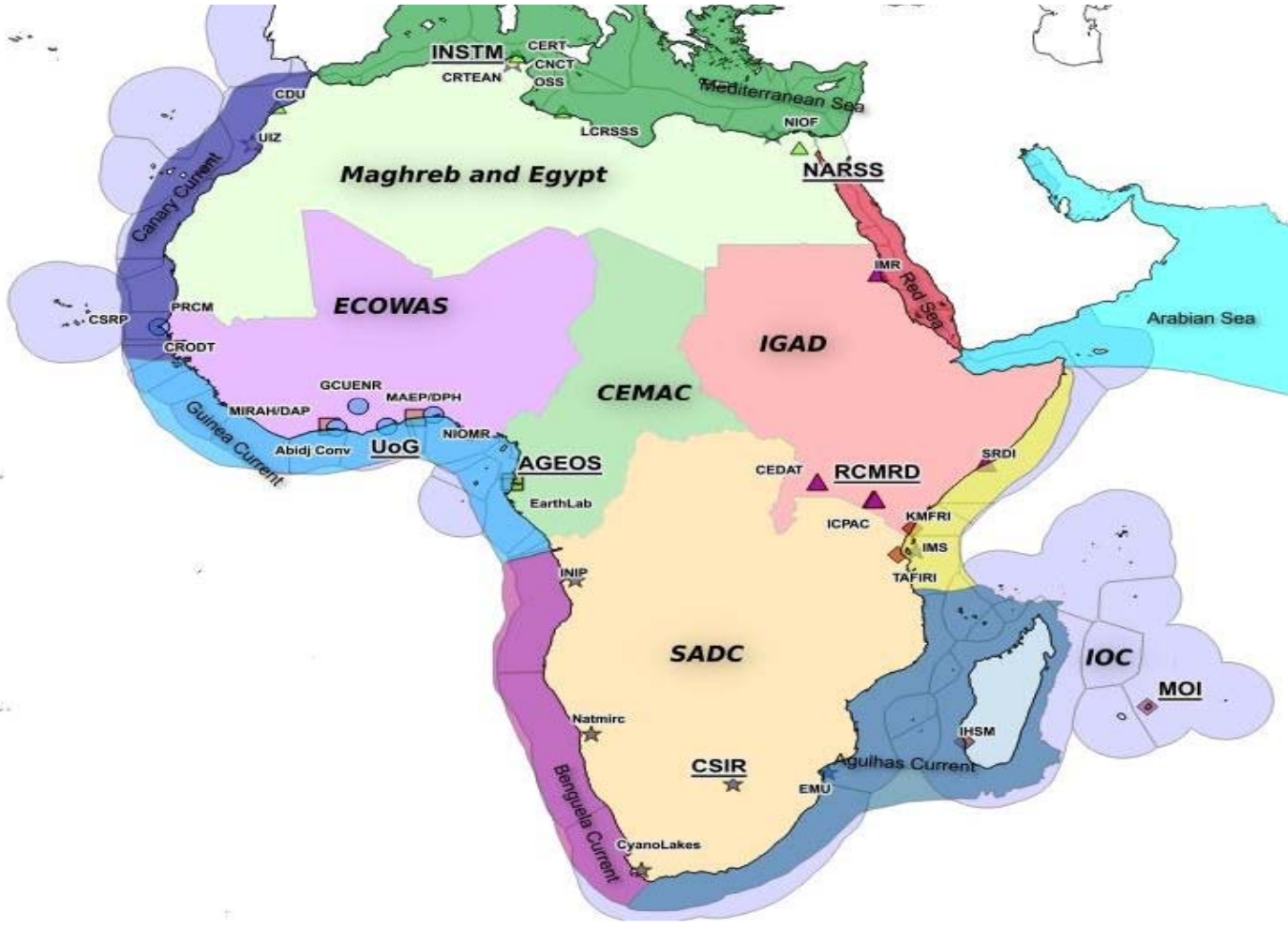

Structure for the Call for Proposals

Call for Proposals in two lots:

1. Water & Natural Resources Services
2. Marine & Coastal Regional Services

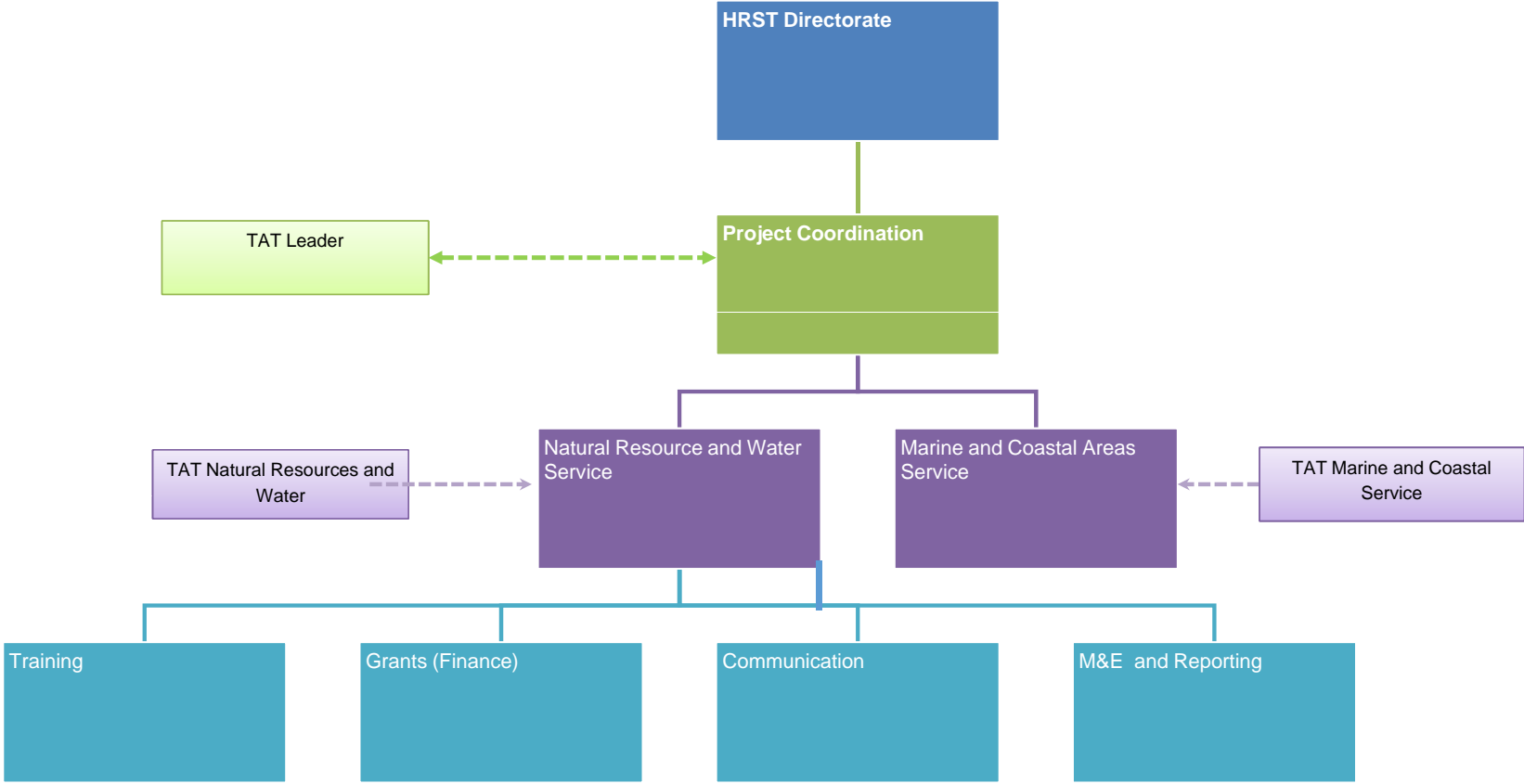
Each of these 2 Services include 3 *segments* constituted as follows:

- (i) **Segment A: Consolidation of an application** already operational in the region concerned by the proposal
- (ii) **Segment B: Extension of an application** already operational from another region;
- (iii) **Segment C: Development of a new application** up to the second stage of the product development cycle (in principle for future continental implementation)

Principles

- RECs to be involved in the entire process of call for proposals;
- To ensure effective implementation of services, these principles are proposed:
 - I. Consortia will be constituted in a way that they contribute to the implementation of regional policies and programmes;
 - II. A consortium cannot submit more than 1 proposal
 - III. No Duplication of services
 - IV. Each region will not receive more than 1 grant for each of the 2 GMES & Africa services;
 - V. Consortia will be assessed on a set objective criteria based on the following principles:
 - i. Adequate regional coverage and policy mandate
 - ii. Technical capacity
 - iii. Financial and Human Resources
 - iv. Experience in regional programmes and international collaboration
